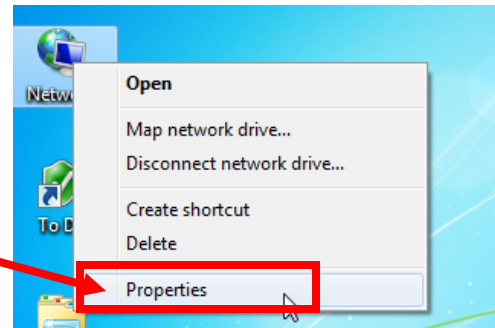
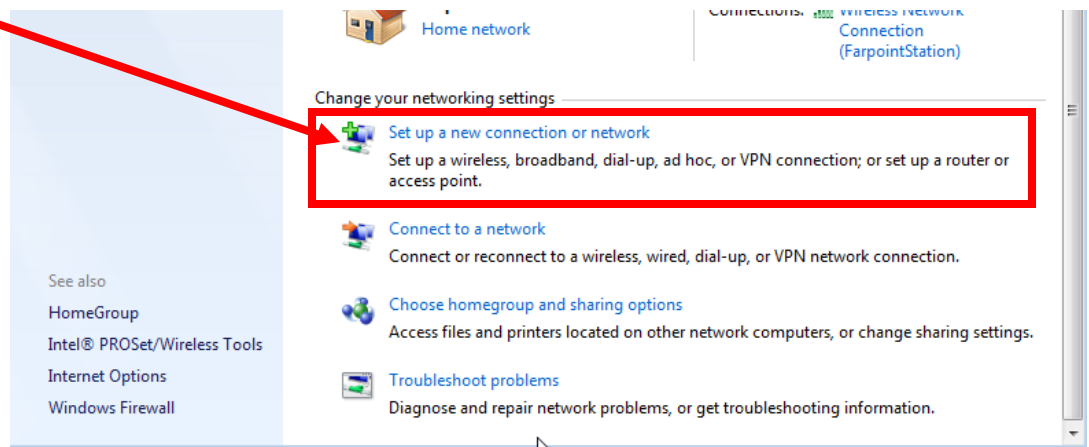


## Setting up the VPN on Windows 7

Right click the **'Network'** icon on the desktop and select Properties.

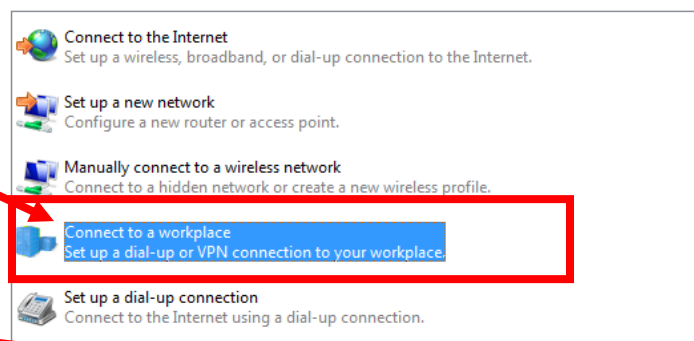


Select **'Set up a new connection or network'**.

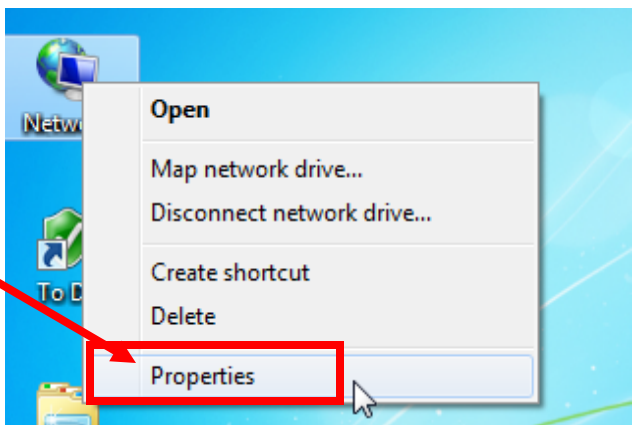

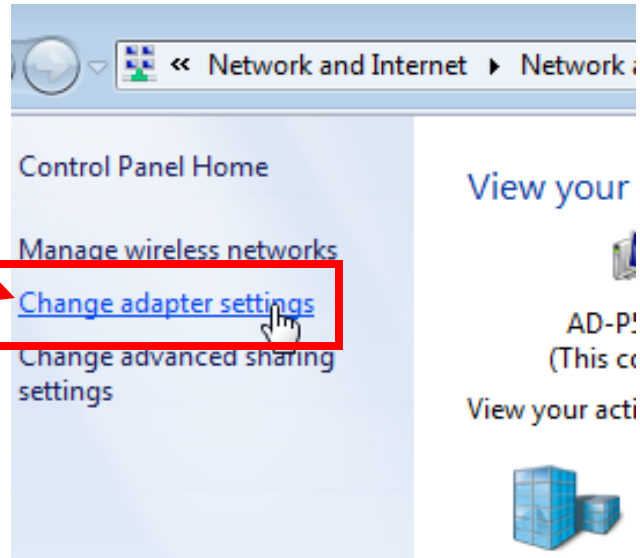

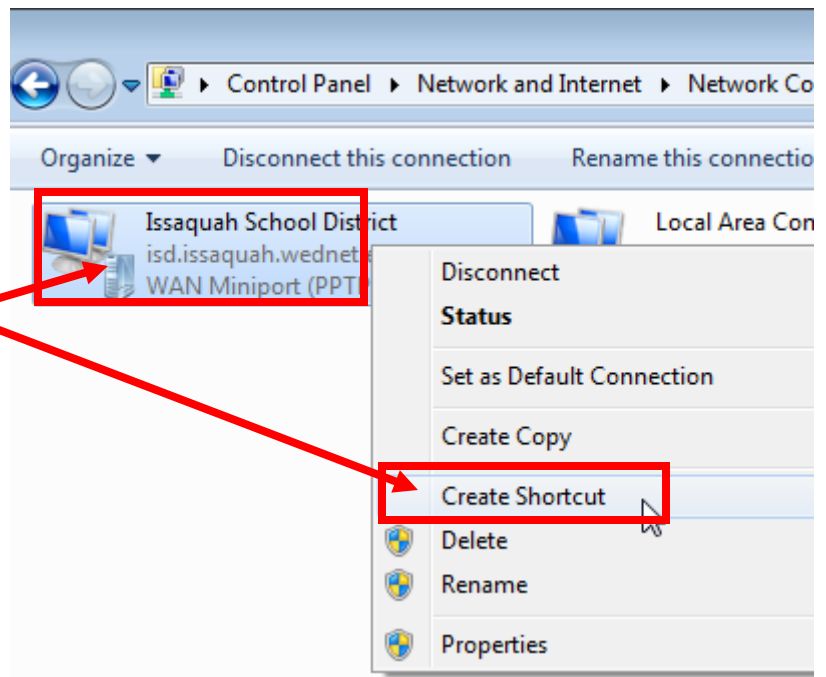
To add the VPN icon to the Desktop right click the Network icon and select Properties.
