March

Registration is required

March 6 : Kindergarten Registration due

Pre-K Assessment for your child in March or April

- Your school will contact you
- You go with your child to the assessment
- The assessment is reading (letters, sounds and a few words)

July

Pre-K Summer school is by invitation

July 6 – July 31

If you are invited:

Pre-K Summer School

- Focus on reading skills and introduction to school
- Free transportation
- Prepares students for Kindergarten

are optional

August

Optional

August 11, 12 and 13 - 9:30 – 10:30 am
