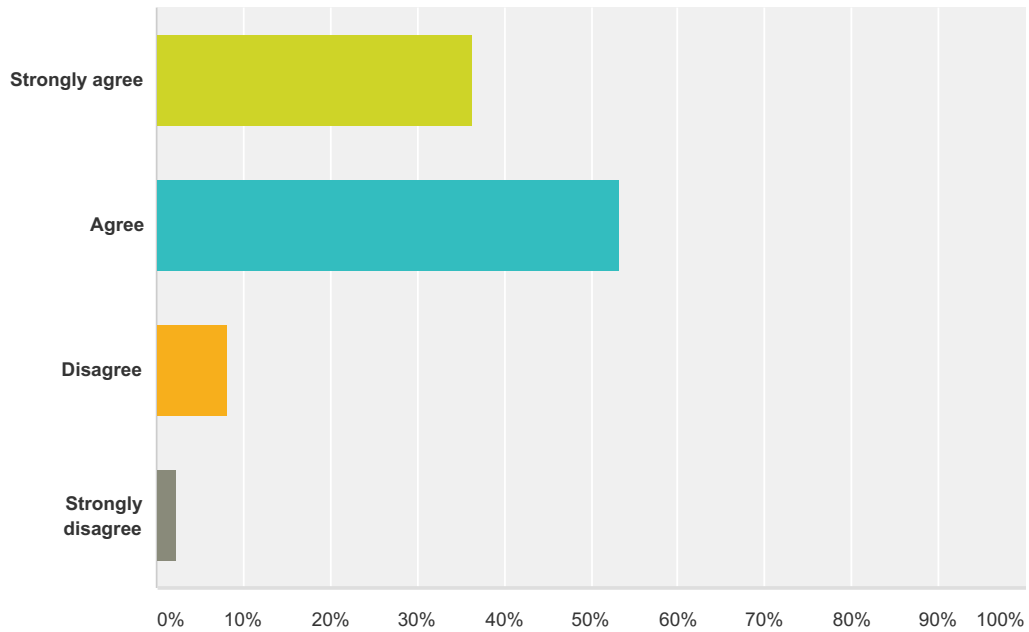


**Q1 In general, I was satisfied with my ability to access the courses I wished to take during my high school years.**

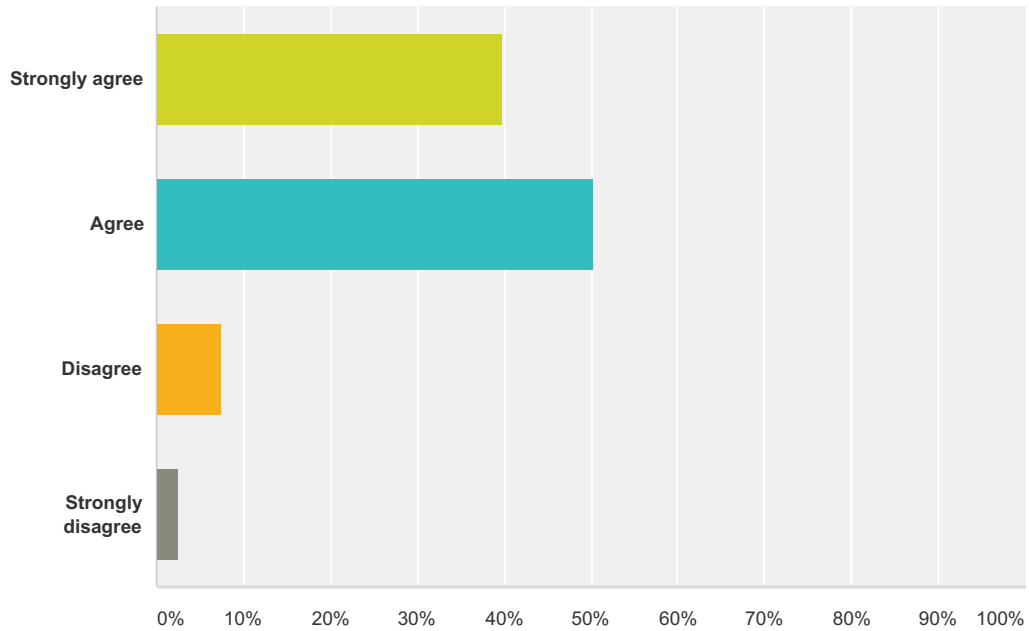

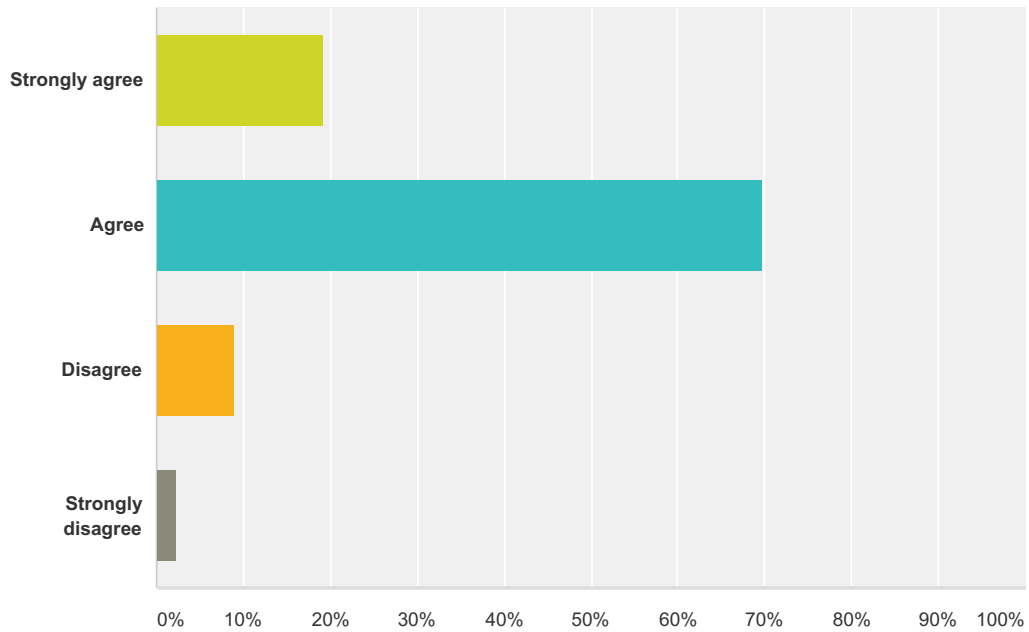

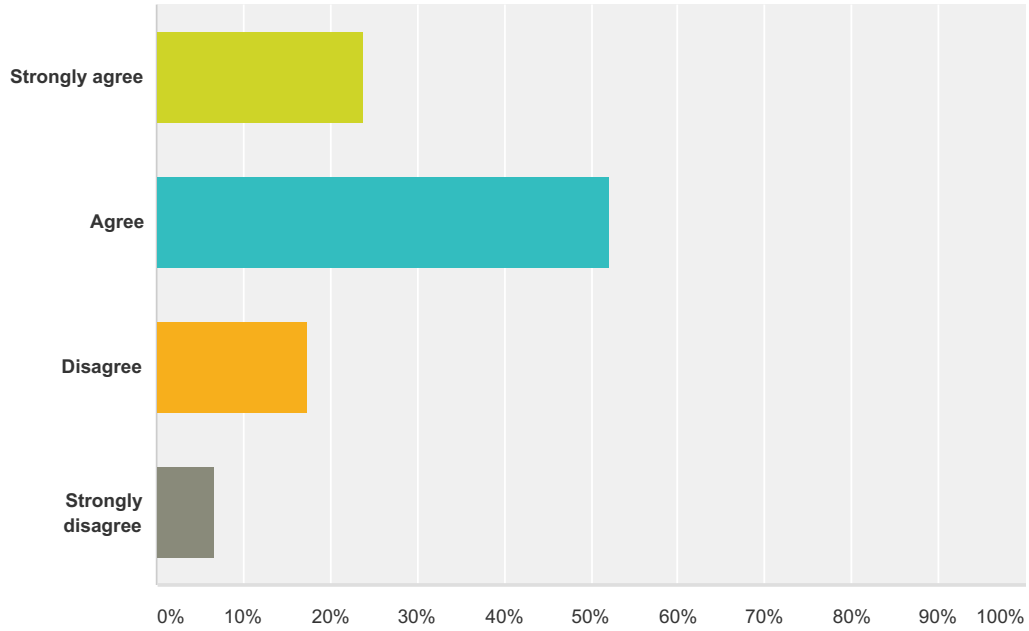

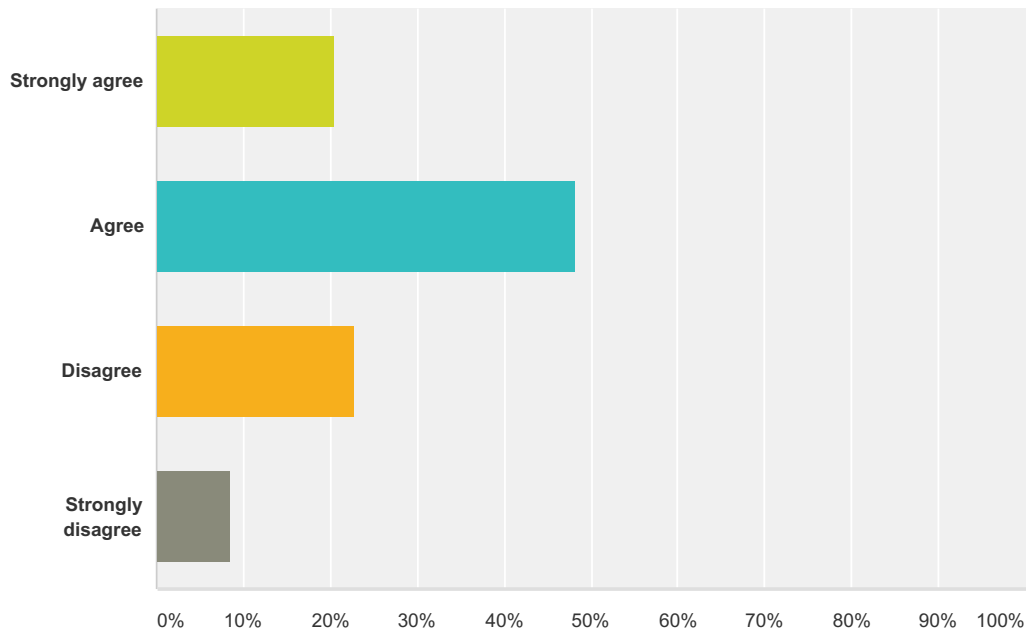

**Q5 In general, I felt very connected to my school during my high school years.**

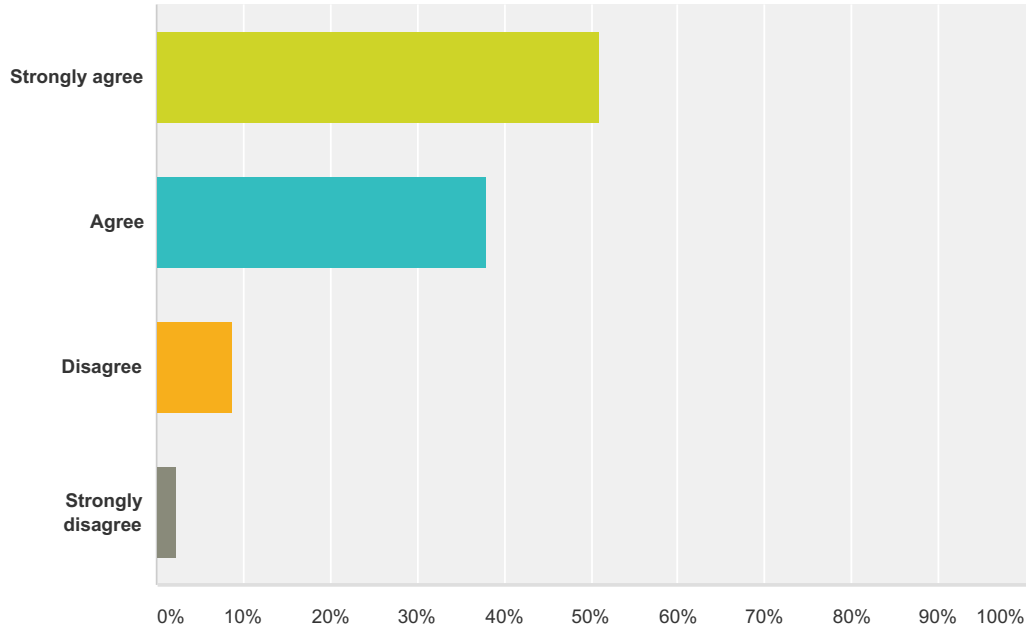

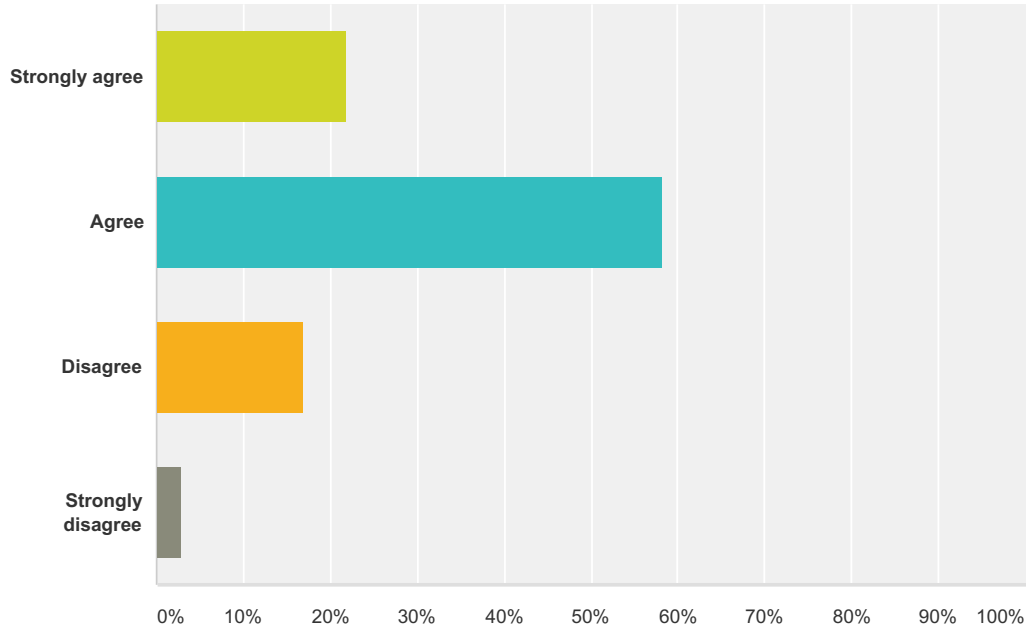

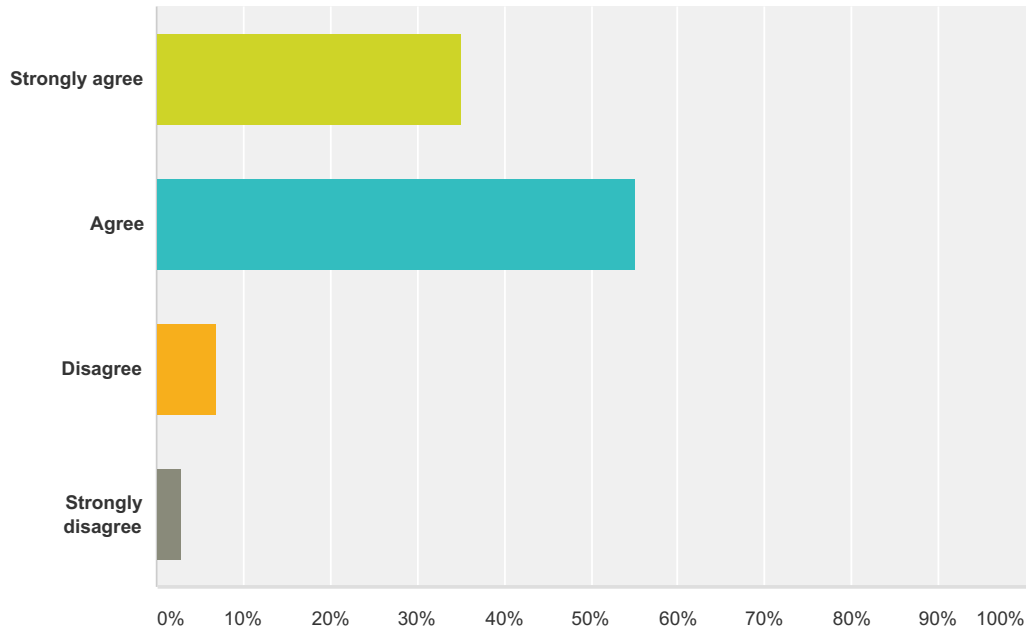

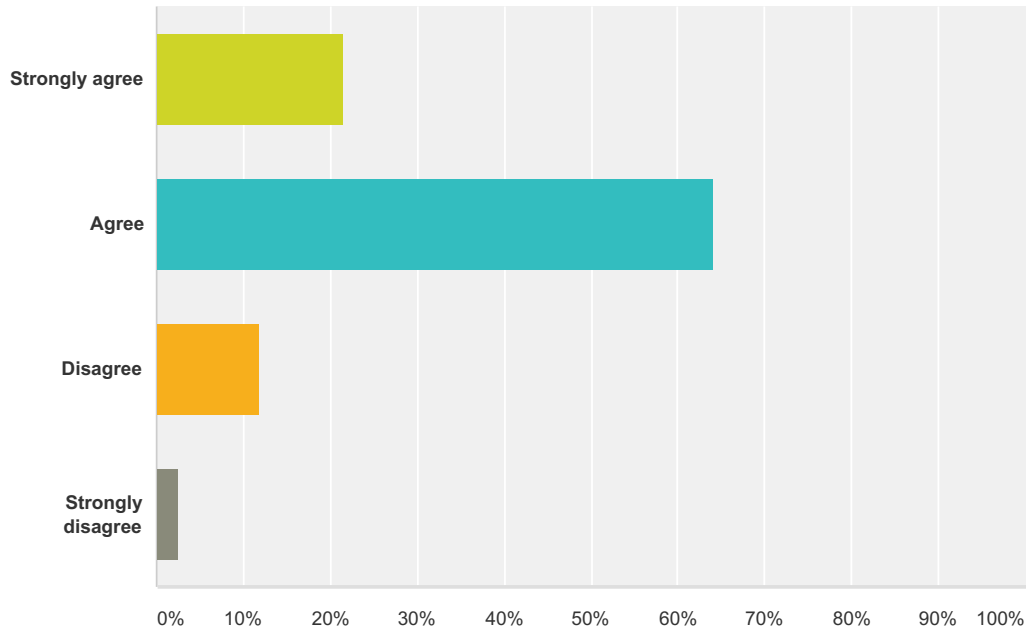

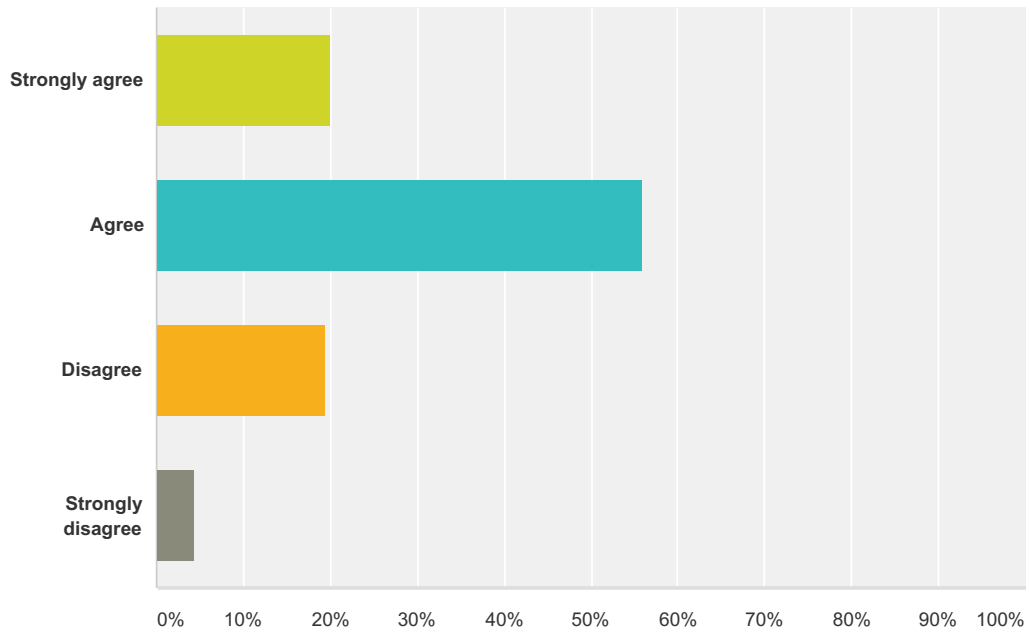

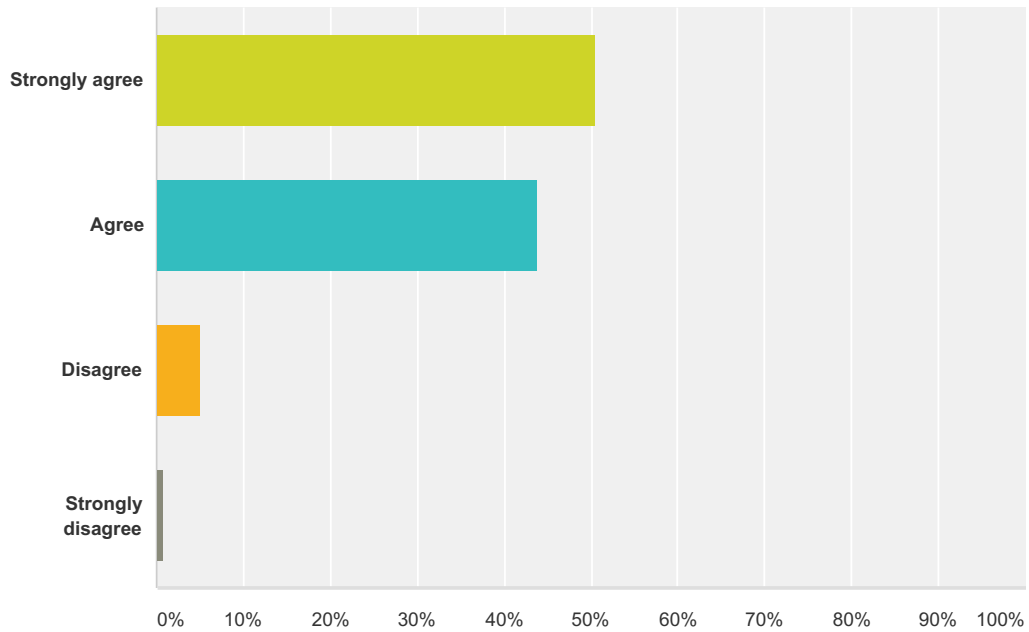
