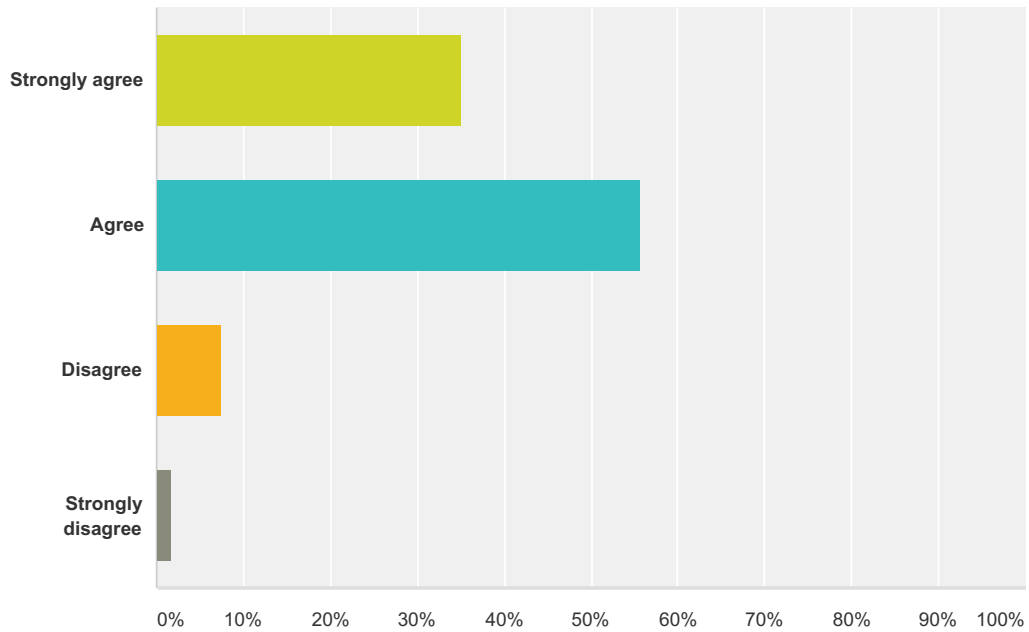


Q1 In general, I was satisfied with my ability to access the courses I wished to take during my high school years.

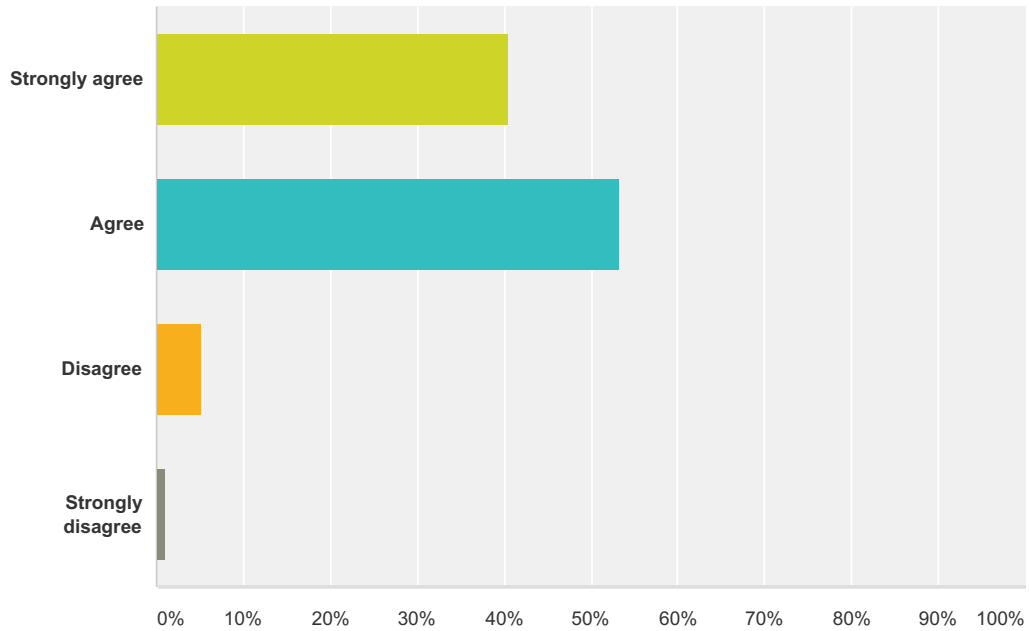

Q2 In general, I was satisfied with my ability to access sports, clubs, and other programs in which I wished to participate during my high school years.

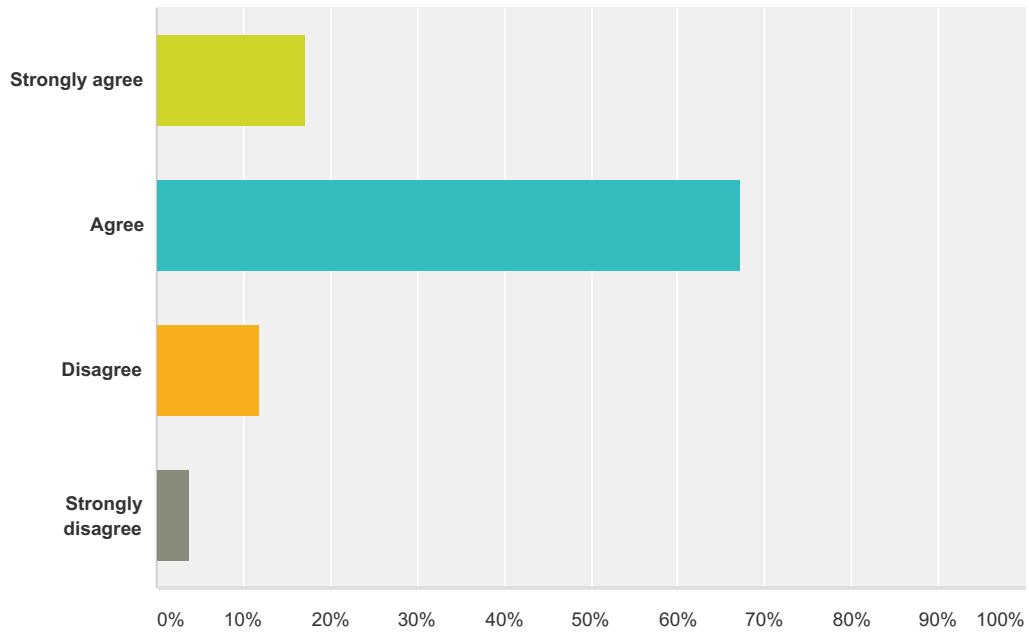

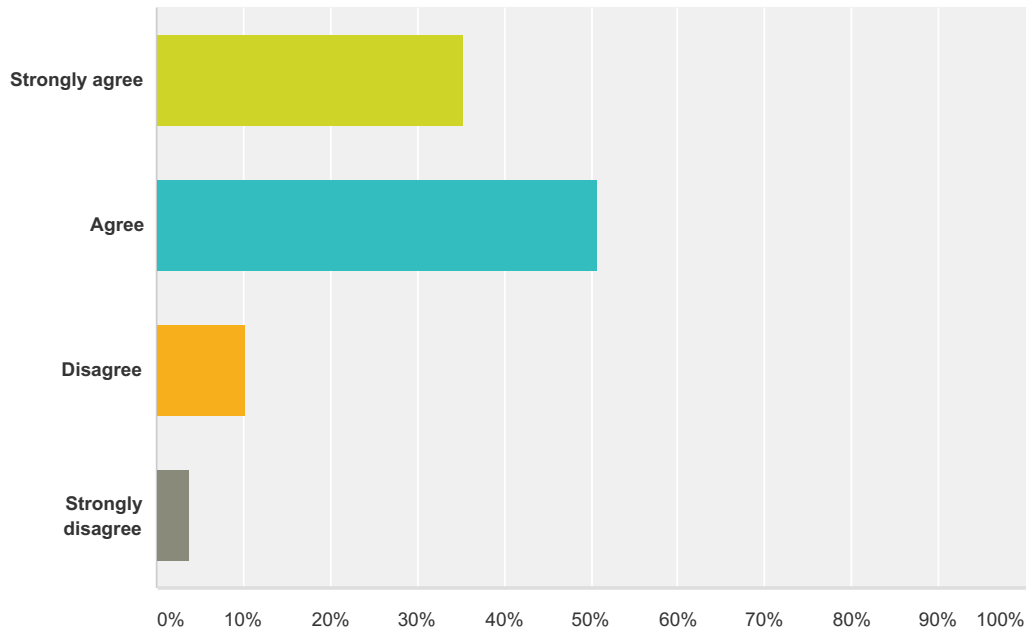

Q4 In general, I was satisfied with the level of counseling support and guidance I received during my high school years.

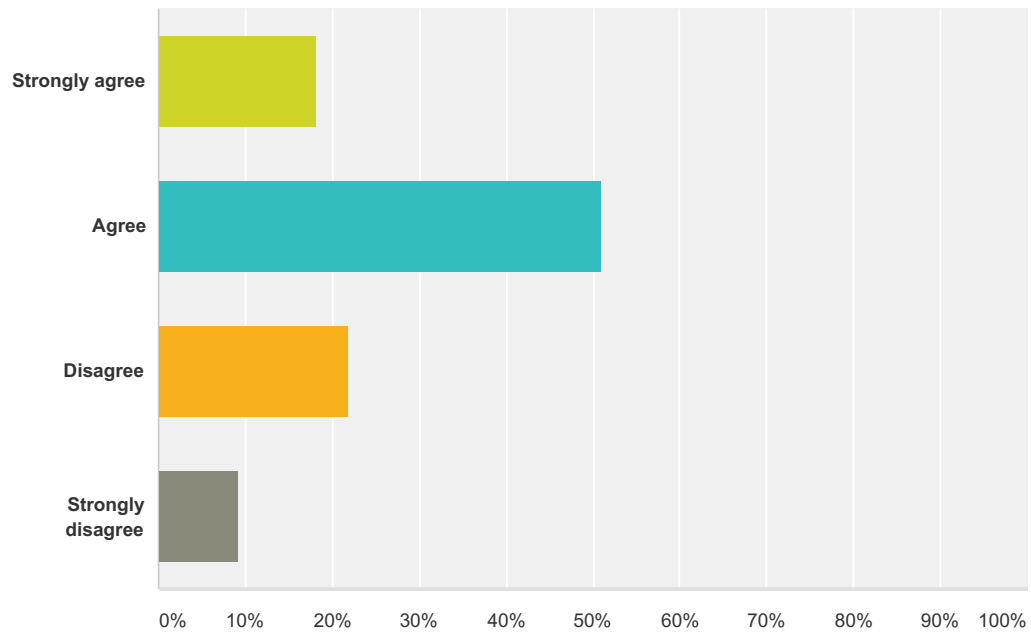

Q5 In general, I felt very connected to my school during my high school years.

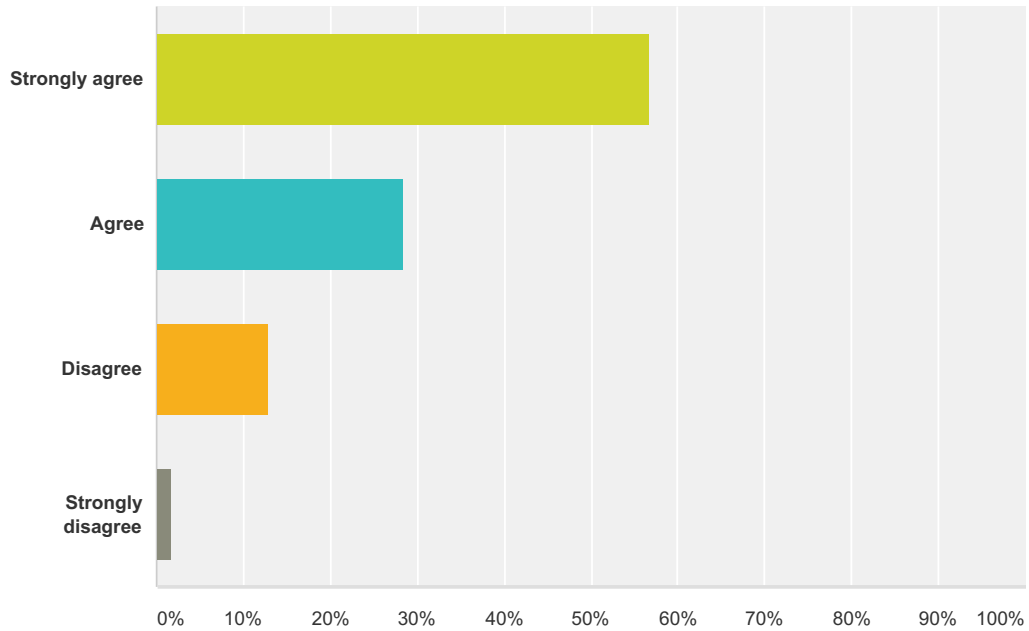

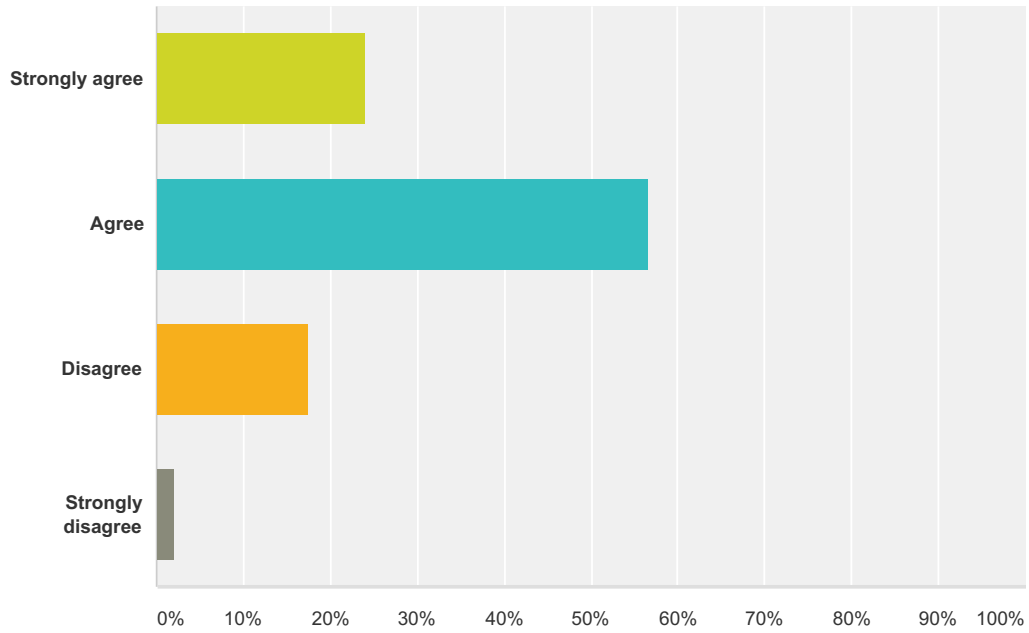

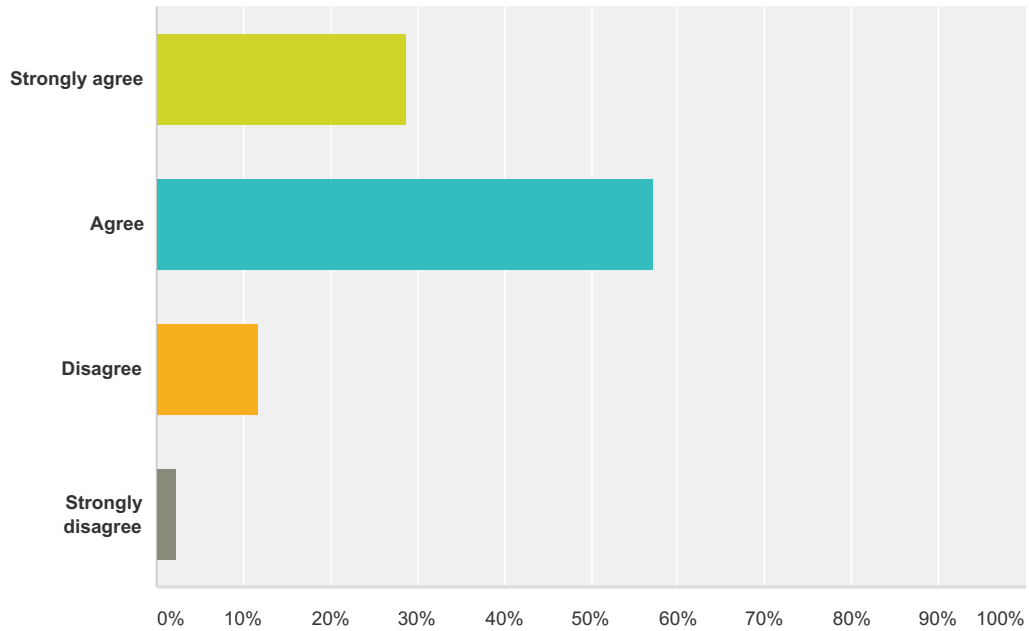

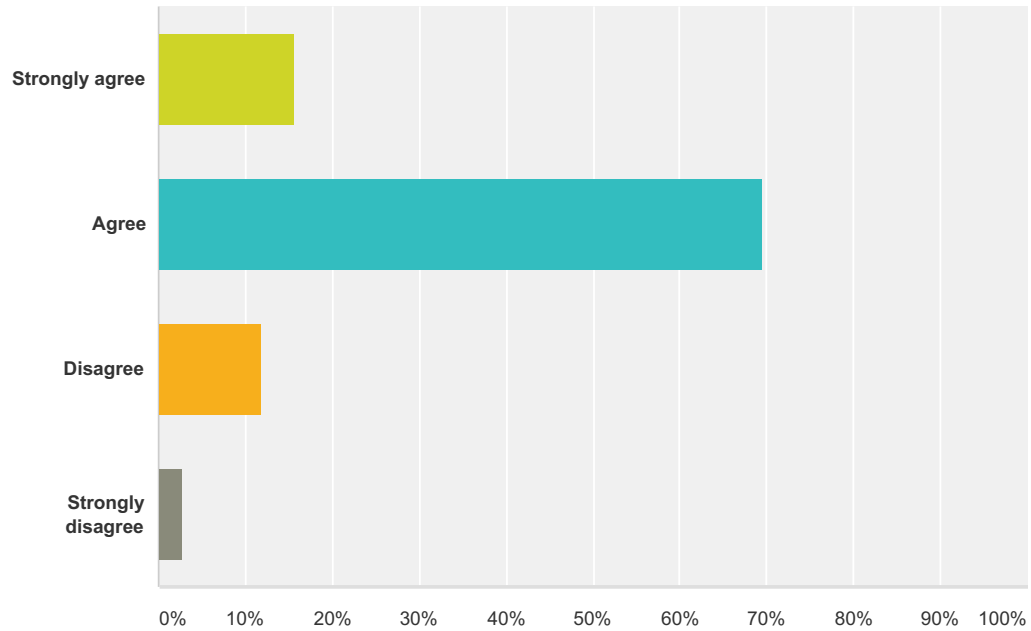

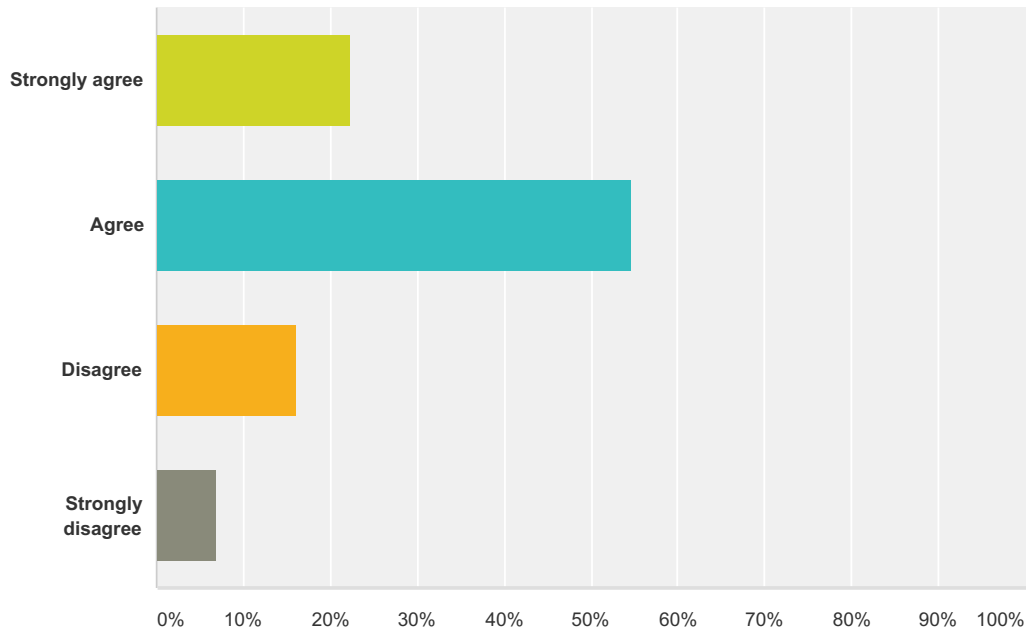

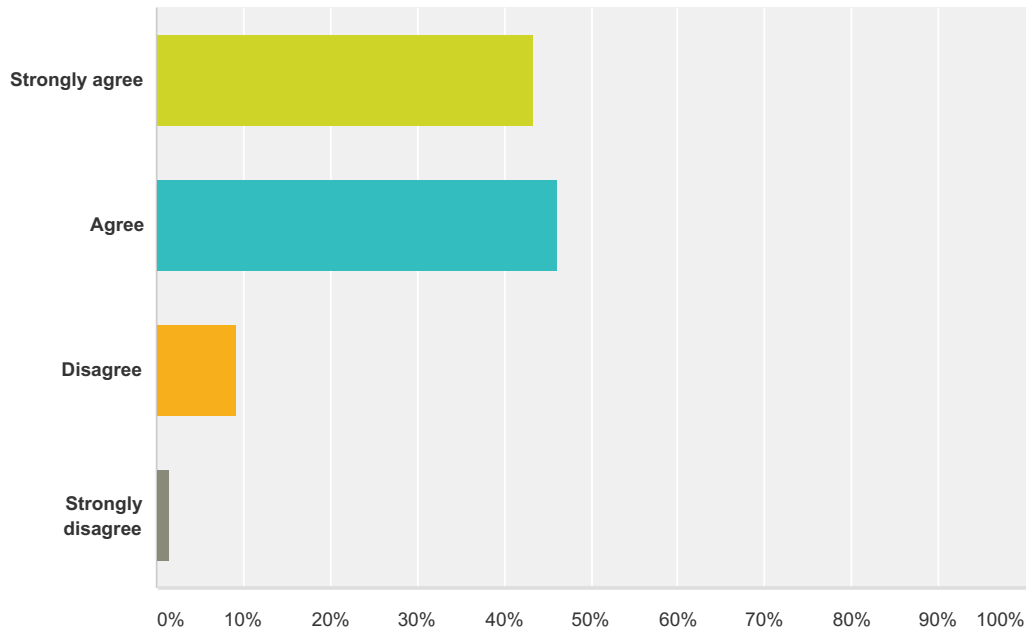
